PAYMENT OF COLLEGE ACCOUNTS

For ease of payment, the JCR Resident Fee is charged in two equal instalments and each semester's fees are payable prior to the beginning of that semester. A student will not normally be allowed to commence a new semester whilst any amount on their Account is unpaid. Queen's College appreciates the substantial commitment which parents make in committing to pay college fees and is intent on making payment procedures as convenient as possible.

The procedures for removal of a student are addressed in the Residential Terms and Agreement, which is available from the College Admission Department. Any change of student resident status requires the prior permission of the Master following a request giving at least four weeks' notice. This notice or request can be sent via email to master@queens.unimelb.edu.au.

CONCESSIONS

Sibling Discount

A reduction in Resident Fees will be applied where two or more siblings of the one family attend the College concurrently. The discount will not apply to the first sibling, but will apply to each subsequent sibling. The discount is \$1,000 (paid in two instalments of \$500 per semester).

Covid Bursary

Queen's College recognises the financial challenges the Covid pandemic brought to the Queen's families. Therefore a bursary of \$1,500 (paid in two instalments of \$750 per semester) will automatically be applied to all JCR returning students. New students will also be receiving a bursary of \$1,000 (paid in two instalments of \$500 per semester).

Scholarships and Bursaries

It is conditional for continued tenure of Scholarships and Bursaries that the College Account remains within the above payment terms.

APPLICATION FEES and ADMISSION DEPOSIT

The Application Fee is \$75 per student (non-refundable). This fee is to offset the administrative costs associated with enrolments. Following an offer of a place at the College, a NON-REFUNDABLE Admission Deposit is payable to secure this enrolment. Deposit is \$1,000, which will be credited towards your Account.

INSURANCE – PERSONAL, PROPERTY & HEALTH

Queen's College accepts no responsibility for damage or loss of personal property (including students' personal effects, computers, bikes, and motor vehicles on site). Nevertheless, the College naturally takes due care to prevent such loss. Parents are strongly advised to make their own arrangements for suitable private health cover.
