



Fee Schedule – Undergraduate Residents 2025

College fees cover accommodation in a furnished private room for semesters one and two, including the mid-semester breaks, but not the mid-year break.

The fees listed in this schedule also cover 3 meals a day, 7 days a week; tutorial program and academic support; leadership and Career Ready programs, internet/wifi access, access to College facilities (library, design studio, common rooms, music rooms etc), utilities (heating, electricity and water), orientation week, lifetime membership with our alumni society, and a fitness membership with Melbourne University Sport.
